I. Budget Update. Dr. Parish presented a budget update to the School Board. This included the process for 2018-19, information on Poquoson City Public Schools and State funding, budget history and enrollment trends. She shared projected increases in expenditures for fiscal year 2019, changes based on the governor's proposed budget and the potential impact on Poquoson City Public Schools' budget. She presented considerations and next steps for the School Board.

II. Recognition of Graduates at Graduation. Dr. Fox presented information to the Board members on the current graduation recognitions, as well as background information on why PCPS does not name a valedictorian and salutatorian. Information was also shared on current trends across the country related to class rank and the naming of a valedictorian.

III. New Matters by Board. Board members would like to revisit the conversation from last month regarding placing information on the agenda for discussion – the request is to review the process which includes speaking with the Board Chair or Superintendent. This will be placed on the agenda for the February work session.
