I. Instructional Data. Dr. Fox gave an instructional update that included AP and SAT data, as well as information on the revised mathematics standards and the implementation timeline for those standards.

II. Policy Change Recommendation. Dr. Parish reviewed School Board Policy 2-2.3 Advertising/Sales/Solicitation with the Board. She informed the Board that any funds that are received as a result of advertising on any field will be put into the general athletic fund and can then be used by either boys or girls sports. Board members requested that the Superintendent follow-up with the School Board attorney on several questions. The updated policy will be brought to the next School Board meeting for a first reading.
