Good afternoon PCPS Families,

At the School Board meeting on Tuesday, March 23, the Board voted to approve the recommendation that we continue to use Wednesdays as a teacher and staff collaborative workday for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year. This means that we will maintain four days of in-person learning for the remainder of the school year. This decision is also applicable to the Friday workday for our adaptive special education and PreK program students.

Students will continue to follow their current schedule on Wednesdays. Students in our adaptive and PreK programs will continue to follow their current schedules on Fridays. At the secondary level, SOL and other local, state, and national testing will occur on Wednesdays, with students attending only if they have an assessment to complete. More information will be shared with families in the near future about SOL testing.

An email was sent on Monday, April 22 to parents of students in Grade 8 and 11 who will be taking the Writing SOL in April. This email can be found [HERE](#) and does ask parents to let us know if their child needs transportation on Wednesday, April 21 or April 28 for SOL testing.
