Good afternoon PHS Parents and Guardians,

Students in Grades 9 - 12 will take End-of-Course (EOC) Standards of Learning (SOL) assessments and Career & Technical Education (CTE) tests on Wednesdays in May and June.

The Grade 11 Writing SOL dates remain Wednesday, April 21 and Wednesday, April 28.

For SOL testing in May and June students will only attend school in person on Wednesdays if they have an SOL or CTE assessment to complete.

The rest of this email only applies to students who will be taking SOL assessments this year:

Testing will begin each morning at 7:20am at Poquoson High School. Students have the length of the school day to complete the assessment as it is untimed. Breakfast and a grab-and-go lunch will be available for students on these testing days.

- May 5 CTE Workplace Readiness Assessment
- May 12 CTE Workplace Readiness Assessment, W!SE Financial Literacy Assessment
- May 19 Biology EOC, Chemistry EOC, US/VA History EOC, World History EOC
- May 26 Grade 11 Reading EOC, World Geography EOC
- June 2 Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II EOC, W!SE Financial Literacy Assess. Retakes
- June 9 SOL Remediation & Term Grad Retakes, CTE: Retail Federation, ParaPro, and Python Assessment

For students who qualify, expedited retakes of SOL assessments will be given on Wednesday June 16, 2021. More information about expedited retakes will be shared with families in May.

PCPS will provide transportation for students who need it on each Wednesday in which your student has an SOL assessment to complete. However, it is important that we know who needs transportation to and from school on the dates listed above.

We are asking ALL parents of students in grades 9-12 who are taking an SOL and/CTE assessment to complete [THIS FORM](#) for each student in your household by Wednesday, April 21, 2021. Families who request PCPS transportation will receive specific information prior to Wednesday, May 5. *Continued on the next page.*
