

Good afternoon PHS and PMS Families,

The following information is for those families who have a student taking an in-person SOL or Workplace Readiness assessment tomorrow, May 5, 2021. Tomorrow's testing schedule includes Workplace Readiness assessment (CTE students in grades 9 - 12), Grade 8 Civics, and Grade 7 Reading.

As we continue our Wednesday testing for middle and high school students, we want to make sure that families have all the information they need. Only those students who are taking an assessment should report to school.

Bus Transportation

Buses will begin picking up students in grades 8-12 at 6:35am and students in grade 7 at 7:05am. Students should be at the designated bus stop at least 10 minutes prior.

To see a list of the stops, click [HERE](#). Look for the box at the top entitled Bus Routes for Wednesday SOL Testing (Grades 6-12 only). Look for your Route Number (ex. P31 AM Central, P37 AM Lower). Listed are the bus stop locations on that route. Using the list of stops on your bus route, you can estimate the time you should arrive at your bus stop.

Buses will depart the high school (grades 8-12) at 9:30am and the middle school (grade 7) at 10:00am. Any student who does not complete their assessment by these times will continue working and a parent will be contacted to coordinate transportation home.

Parent Drop-off and Pick-Up

Parents who are dropping students off for testing should ensure that students in grades 8-12 arrive at PHS by 7:10am and students in grade 7 arrive at the PMS trailers by 7:40am. Students in grades 8-12 should enter through the main entrance for a temperature screening. Students in grade 7 should report to their first period class.

Students in grades 9-12 will receive a pass when they complete their test and should present this pass to Mrs. Insley prior to leaving the building, whether they drove themselves or are being picked up by a parent.

Students in grades 7 and 8 will call their parents once they have completed their assessment. 8th grade parents should report to the vestibule at the PHS main entrance to sign their child out. 7th grade parents should report to the PMS Main Office (Trailer 5) located in front of PES to sign their child out.

Chromebooks and Chargers

Students will be taking their SOL and other assessments on their Chromebooks. When they come to school to take a test, they will need to bring their Chromebook and charger with them. We ask students and parents to make sure their Chromebook is fully charged when they come on Wednesdays.

RUVNA Health Screening

Parents of those students who are taking an assessment tomorrow, May 5, will receive a text message with the RUVNA daily health screener. We ask parents to please complete this prior to their student arriving at school. For our Poquoson Online families, this will be the first time the health screening text is used. Breakfast is available to all students when they arrive and a grab and go lunch is available when students leave school.
