SUPERINTENDENT'S REGULATION 5-8.5 (B) PERFORMANCE CHARACTERISTICS

Principals shall exhibit the following positive performance characteristics:

Knowledge Depth and breadth of knowledge in management and supervisory services.

Planning Evidence of planning in administrative or supervisory actions.

Organization Extent to which work is well organized plus that of those supervised.

Initiative Willingness to act without undue prodding.

Follow-through Effectiveness in carrying out plans and actions.

Decision-making Evidence of soundness in making decisions.

Communication Extent to which superiors and subordinates are kept informed about school.

Staff Involvement Utilization of staff in management of school.

Temperament Emotional maturity.

Cooperation Willingness to get along with others.

Loyalty Commitment to the welfare of colleagues and the school division.

Dependability Steadfastness to fulfilling duties.

Imagination Degree to which innovations and new ideas are undertaken.

Accountability Willingness to be held responsible for leadership behavior.

Judgment Use of good sense in leadership behavior.
